



In 2007 the California Violence Prevention Network (CalVPN) was founded on the belief that nothing would change—crime would not be reduced and communities would remain frightened—unless essential city and county agencies and the non profit, faith, and profit sectors pledged to partnership goals linked to specific actions in the prevention, intervention, reentry and enforcement arenas.

Given the decrease in crime and progress in communities across California, it is now critically important to view this work through a new lens, *a healing lens*. At this year's conference, the "Healing" lens will focus on four areas. You will hear personal stories from youth who have moved from trauma to healing. What made the difference? Who made the difference? Just as important, how do we heal the healers? We will learn how those working with the traumatized and angry, the "healers," stay on their feet, re-energize, and heal themselves. We will explore how law enforcement and community wounds can be healed, and vital partnership established. From mentoring through street work, after-school programs and "Call-In's," we will explore the essential healing role played by the faith community.
